

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Candidates are required to apply for TS PGECET-2019 test through Online mode only (**printed hard copy of the applications will not be accepted**).
2. The application / registration fee is Rs. 1000/- (Rs 500/- in case of SC/ST) per test. In case a candidate wants to appear for more than one test, separate registration fee has to be paid for each test.
3. The examination will be conducted in Online Mode only i.e., Computer Based Test (CBT).
4. The examination will be held from 10.00 AM to 12.00 Noon (Reporting time at the test centre will be 09:00AM) in the morning session and 2.00PM to 4.00 PM (Reporting time at the test centre will be 01:00 PM) for the afternoon sessions as per the Time Table given in Test Schedule.
5. Computer Based Test (CBT) is of two hour duration with 120 multiple choice objective type questions, carrying one mark for each question. No negative marks will be awarded for incorrect answer. The cut-off mark in the Common Entrance Test is 30 marks, in case of SC/ST there is no minimum marks.
6. The Question Papers will be in English only, syllabus of each test paper is given in [Annexure-A](#)
7. Candidates must ensure that they choose the correct test paper, which qualifies them to become eligible to seek admission to the specific program they are interested in. The details of the courses offered by the Universities along with specified eligibility for each course and test to be written is given in [Annexure-B](#). Candidates should ensure that they satisfy the eligibility criteria for admission into the preferred program as given in [Annexure-B](#).
8. TS PGECET-2019 will be held at two different regional centers in the State of Telangana i.e., Hyderabad and Warangal.
9. As per AICTE the eligibility criterion for admission to Engineering and Pharmacy is 50% in the qualifying examination (45% for reserved category). Further, the qualifying degree (Professional courses) obtained under distance mode must have **AICTE / Distance Education Council (DEC)** approval.
10. Candidate should satisfy local/non local status requirements as per [GO Ms No 153](#).
11. The Hall-Tickets are to be downloaded from the website: <http://pgcet.tsche.ac.in/> without Hall-Tickets the candidate will not be allowed into the test centre.
12. Appearing in the test does not guarantee admission. The candidate has to satisfy all the requirements at the time of admission.
